

## **COURSE TITLES WITH DISTANCE EDUCATION COMPONENTS: COMBINATION REPORT**

This combination report is the result of concatenating data generated by our web survey, AOCE, UOnline/TACC, Utah System of Higher Education State Board of Regents Report, and listings supplied by numerous individual departments, programs and colleges.

We are able to itemize **349 unique course titles from 55 sponsoring departments and programs spanning the Summer Semester of 2006 to Spring Semester 2008**. The 349 courses mean that of all the courses taught at the University of Utah, 349 included distance education components. Naturally, the same course may have multiple sections and may have repeated across different semesters. *The total number of course occurrences is not reported here, just the total number of course titles that have distance education components for the time period specified.* Courses represent both undergraduate and graduate work. These courses cover the spectrum of offerings with distance education components, including Online, Broadcast/ Telecourse, Correspondence Courses, with a mixture of synchronous, asynchronous and blended instructional events. Given the challenge of gathering sufficient and accurate data, it can be assumed that no less than 296 course titles have distance education components; likely the number is higher.
